Day 1: Defiant Mothers   Scripture: Exodus 1:17 NKJV "But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive."
Day 2: A Difficult Pregnancy   Scripture: Genesis 16:7-8 NKJV "Now the Angel of the Lord found her by a spring of water in the wilderness, by the spring on the way to Shur. And He said, "Hagar, Sarai's maid, where have you come from, and where are you going?" She said, "I am fleeing from the presence of my mistress Sarai."
Day 3: Jochebed: A Mother of Faith   Scripture: Exodus 2:1-2 MEV "Now a man of the house of Levi went and married a daughter of Levi. And the woman conceived and bore a son, and when she saw him, that he was a beautiful child, she hid him three months."
Day 4: The Next Generation   Scripture: Judges 13:5 NKJV "For behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. And no razor shall come upon his head, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb; and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines."
Day 5: A Shining Example   Scripture: Ruth 1:16 MEV "But Ruth said, "Do not urge me to leave you or to turn back from following you. For wherever you go, I will go, and wherever you stay, I will stay. Your people shall be my people and your God my God.""
Day 6: God's Divine Favor   Scripture: Luke 1:13-14 NKJV "But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard; and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth."
Day 7: Daughters For A Season   Scripture: Ruth 1:8 NCV "But Naomi said to her two daughters-in-law, "Go back home, each of you to your own mother's house. May the Lord be as kind to you as you have been to me and my sons who are now dead."
Day 8: The Mother Who Doubted   Scripture: Genesis 21:2-3 ESV "And Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age at the time of which God had spoken to him. Abraham called the name of his son who was born to him, whom Sarah bore him, Isaac."
Day 9: Discovering Her Identity   Scripture: Genesis 29:32 MEV "Leah conceived and gave birth to a son, and she called his name Reuben, for she said, "Surely the Lord has looked upon my affliction. Now therefore my husband will love me."
Day 10: Faithful To God   Scripture: 1 Samuel 1:10-11 ESV "She was deeply distressed and prayed to the Lord and wept bitterly. And she vowed a vow and said, "O Lord of hosts, if you will indeed look on the affliction of your servant and remember me and not forget your servant, but will give to your servant a son, then I will give him to the Lord all the days of his life, and no razor shall touch his head." Day 12: Mother Of Israel   Scripture: Judges 5:7 NKJV "Village life ceased, it ceased in Israel, until I, Deborah, arose, arose a mother in Israel."
Day 13: Shaping The Heart   Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:5 ESV "I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well."
Day 14: Sharing Our Lives   Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 2:7-8 AMP "But we behaved gently when we were among you, like a devoted mother tenderly caring for her own children. Having such a deep affection for you, we were delighted to share with you not only God's good news but also our own lives, because you had become so very dear to us."
Day 15: She Speaks With Wisdom   Scripture: Proverbs 31:26 NIV "She speaks with wisdom, and faithful instruction is on her tongue."
Day 16: The Blessing Of A Praying Mom   Scripture: Philippians 1:3-4 MEV "I thank my God for every reminder of you. In every prayer of mine for you all, I have always made requests with joy"
Day 17: Love In Action   Scripture: 1 John 3:18 MEV "My little children, let us love not in word and speech, but in action and truth"
Day 18: Rest For The Weary   Scripture: Matthew 11:28 NIV "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."
Day 19: Letting Go Of What Others Think   Scripture: Luke 1:38 ESV "And Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word"
